Lemon Coral® Sedum

Durable, drought tolerant, colorful succulent for containers and landscapes. Very easy to grow. Zones 7-11. Part sun to sun. Height: 3"-10".



Bobo® Hydrangea

Masses of flowers that bloom reliably every year on dwarf plants make this a very popular hydrangea. Zones 3-11. Part sun-sun. Height: 30"-36".



Whirlwind® White Scaevola

Fan-shaped flowers line the stems of this very heat tolerant annual all season long. Zones 10-11. Sun. Height: 8"-14".



ColorBlaze® Velveteen® Solenostemon

Adds a bright spot of fuchsia and purple to the garden all season on full, upright plants. Zones 10-11. Sun-shade. Height: 24"-40".



Fine Line® Rhamnus

A narrow, upright form makes this fernleaf shrub ideal for hedging or as a single focal point. Zones 2-7. Part sun-sun. Height: 60"-84".



Stratosphere™ Pink Picotee Gaura

Lovely in landscapes and as a thriller in containers, this perennial blooms non-stop all season on wispy stems. Zones 6-11. Sun. Height: 12"-24".



Lemon A-Peel® Thunbergia

This annual vine will give you color all summer long while climbing happily up whatever support you give it. Zones 10-11. Part sun to sun. Height: 5'-8'.



Truffula™ Pink Gomphrena

Hot pink, orb-shaped blossoms appear all season on heat, humidity and drought tolerant plants. Zones 9-11. Sun. Height: 22"-28".



Supertunia® Bordeaux™ Petunia

One of the most popular petunias ever. Masses of color all season without deadheading. Zones 10-11. Part sun-sun. Height: 6"-12".



Supertunia® Black Cherry™ Petunia

Deep red flowers blanket the mounded to trailing plants all season without deadheading. Zones 10-11. Part sun-sun. Height: 6"-12".



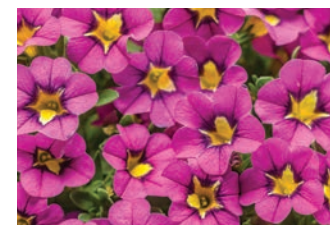
Sweet Caroline Raven™ Ipomoea

An essential trailing component for containers; also makes a great groundcover. Zone 11. Part sun-sun. Height: 6"-16".



Superbena Sparkling® Ruby Verbena

Large clusters of two-tone pink flowers appear abundantly on spreading/trailing plants in containers and landscapes. Zones 8-11. Part sun-sun. Height: 6"-12".



Superbells® Hollywood Star™ Calibrachoa

Fuchsia pink blossoms with gold stary centers appear abundantly on cascading stems all season. Zones 9-11. Part sun-sun. Height: 6"-12".



Graceful Grasses® Blue Mohawk® Juncus

Spiky blue foliage makes a fun thriller in patio containers and landscapes. Zones 5-9. Part sun-sun. Height: 24"-36".
