
Tall stems lined with blue-purple flowers add height and structure to large containers and landscapes. Zones 10-11. Sun. Height: 30"-40".



Luscious[®] Bananarama[™] Lantana Fragrant, bright yellow flowers attract pollinators all season on heat and drought tolerant plants. Zones 9-11. Sun. Height: 20"-30"

Hippo[®] Pink *Hypoestes* Colorful foliage splashed with pink and green. Easy to mix with other plants in combinations. Zones 10-11. Part shade-shade. Height: 16"-22".







Bright Lights[™] Double Moonglow Osteospermum Double, creamy yellow blossoms thrive in cooler weather; deer resistant, attracts butterflies. Zones 9-11, Part sun-sun, Height; 8"-12".




Artist® Blue Ageratum Small, fluffy button-like flowers add color and attract pollinators all season; no deadheading needed. Zones 9-10. Part sun-sun. Height: 8"-12".



Supertunia® Mini Vista Hot Pink Petunia Hot pink flowers blanket these vigorous, mounding to spreading plants all season. Zones 10-11. Part sun-sun. Height: 6"-12".



Tiny, white flowers dance above this airy textured, extremely heat and drought tolerant plant all season. Zones 8-11. Sun. Height: 48"-96".





Luscious[®] Rovale Cosmo Lantana Fragrant, pink and yellow bicolor flowers attract





Blue My Mind[®] Evolvulus True blue flowers appear on spreading, silvery-green plants all summer without deadheading. Extremely heat tolerant. Zones 9-11. Sun. Height: 6"-12".

Señorita Rosalita® Cleome Heat and drought tolerant plant with odorless foliage that adds height and drama to gardens and landscapes. Zones 10-11. Sun. Height: 24"-48".
